Thank you for your interest in having a stall at our Christmas Art & Craft Fair! Our event is an annual fundraiser as we are independent charitable Trust (The Julia Margaret Cameron Trust, registered charity No. 1026339) which helps supports the museums work.

We are always delighted by the number of talented makers who want to take part. Unfortunately, our venue has limited space, so we cannot accommodate everyone who applies.

To make the process as fair as possible, we are implementing the following guidelines:

- We only accept high-quality, handmade items made on the Island by local makers.*
- We are unable to accept items from sellers of manufactured items.*
- To keep the fair exciting, we aim to offer visitors a wide variety of stalls so there may be a limit to the number of stalls selling similar products.*
- While we value our loyal stallholders who return each year, we also recognise the importance of welcoming new makers.*

Please note that just because you have registered doesn't automatically mean you have been approved. If you are successful, you will be contacted on or before the 6th of October.

If your application is not successful this year, we will add you to our waiting list. Should a space become available, we will contact waiting list applicants in the order they were received.

Please know that although we have more applications than space available, we truly value the time, skill, and creativity of every maker who applies.

We will be hosting a fundraising raffle alongside the fair to raise funds for the Trust and would be extremely grateful if you are able to provide a prize (Draw will take place at 3pm on the Sunday).

Guidelines and Terms & Conditions, please read:

- Only local people making and selling their own work are eligible.*
- Manufactured goods cannot be sold.*
- The price for a standard 6ft x 3ft pitch is £55 for the weekend. This pitch size includes the space for yourself, so you will either have to go behind your table or next to it.*
- If your table is bigger than what you have paid for or you require extra space, you will be charged at £5 per ft. (for example a 8ft space would be priced at £65)*
- You should provide your own table*
- Please note you will not be able to pick your spot. You will be allocated a spot based on the information you provide*
- Please note room sizes/layouts vary due to the nature of the building.*
- Please do not pay for you stall until you have received confirmation to do so.*
- Payment must be made prior to the event.*
- Setup times: Friday 13th Nov, 4pm–6pm; Sat & Sun from 9am*
- Displays must stay within the area you have paid for.*
- Hanging works on walls is not permitted.*

-Please do not alter the lights.

- Card sales can be taken at Dimbola's front desk (5% commission to cover costs). Guidance regarding the procedure for this will be given on the day.

- Stallholders must remove money from the site daily.

- Stallholders must steward their stall and handle all sales (except card sales at the front desk) during public opening hours (10am–4pm).

- No parking in front of Dimbola during opening hours (10am–4pm). Free parking available on Gate Lane.

- Stallholders are responsible for insurance covering loss, damage, or injury.

- A raffle will be held on Sunday 15th November for fundraising. Contributions of prizes are greatly appreciated. (Draw 3pm).

As a thank you for participating, stall holders will be entitled to one free tea or instant coffee each day (upgrades available for a fee), and 10% off purchases in our tearoom/giftshop all weekend.
